Option 1

Option 2

- **Register:** Register <u>online via TurboVote</u>. Online voter registration for the Illinois primary election is available until March 3, 2024. Same-day registration is available during <u>early voting or on election day</u>. During this time frame, you can register and vote at the same time. Proper identification is required.
- Vote Early: Avoid lines on election day and vote early. All students registered in McLean County (except Bloomington residents) are eligible to vote at one of the on-campus locations.

- Vote by Mail: If you cannot make it to a polling place during an early voting time or on Election Day, you can request a ballot request application and a pre-paid envelope through <u>TurboVote</u>. When you receive your application in the mail, you'll need to fill it out and sign it according to the instructions. March 14 is the last day to <u>request a Vote by Mail ballot</u> electronically.
- Vote on Election Day: Illinois primary election day is March 19, 2024. Polling place hours are 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. If you are in line by 7 p.m., you are entitled to vote. Not sure where to go to vote? Illinois voters can <u>look up their polling place</u> <u>online</u>. All students registered in McLean County (except Bloomington residents) are eligible to vote at the Brown Ballroom in the Bone Student Center.

Option 3

Important Dates:

February 8: Vote by Mail ballots begin mailing to those who requested them

February 8 – March 18: Early voting available at Eastland Mall and McLean County Government Center

March 3: Last day to register to vote online

March 4 - 15: Early voting opens at the Bone Student Center and Watterson

March 14: Last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot electronically

March 19: Election Day at the Bone and deadline for Vote by Mail ballots to be postmarked
