# INCLUDING ELECTION INFO IN YOUR SYLLABUS



#### Option 1

Check out the Redbird Voter Guide at <u>IllinoisState.edu/Vote</u> to learn more about voting on campus. The General Election is November 5.

## Option 2

- Register: Register <u>online via TurboVote</u>. Online voter registration for the Illinois General Election is available until October 20, 2024. Same-day registration is available during <u>early voting or on election day</u>. During this time frame, you can register and vote at the same time. Proper identification is required.
- Vote Early: Avoid lines on election day and vote early. All students registered in McLean County (except Bloomington residents) are eligible to vote at one of the oncampus locations.
  - October 21- 25; October 28 November 1
  - o 10:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.
  - o Bone Student Center, Founders Suite
- Vote by Mail: If you cannot make it to a polling place during an early voting time or on Election Day, you can request a ballot request application and a pre-paid envelope through <u>TurboVote</u>. When you receive your application in the mail, you'll need to fill it out and sign it according to the instructions. October 31 is the last day to <u>request a Vote by Mail ballot</u> electronically.
- Vote on Election Day: General Election Day is November 5, 2024. Polling place
  hours are 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. If you are in line by 7 p.m., you are entitled to
  vote. Not sure where to go to vote? Illinois voters can look up their polling place
  online. All students registered in McLean County (except Bloomington residents) are
  eligible to vote at the Brown Ballroom in the Bone Student Center.

## Option 3

#### **Important Dates:**

August 7: First day to request a Vote by Mail ballot for the general election.

September 26: Vote by Mail ballots begin mailing to those who request them.

October 31: Deadline to request a Vote by Mail ballot.

November 5: Election Day: Polls open at Bone Student Center; Last day for Vote by Mail ballots to be postmarked. Polling place hours are 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. If you are in line by 7 p.m., you are entitled to vote

November 19: Deadline for Vote by Mail ballots to be received.
