

INCLUDING ELECTION INFO IN YOUR SYLLABUS



Option 1

Check out the Redbird Voter Guide at IllinoisState.edu/Vote to learn more about voting on campus. Election Day is November 8, 2022.

Option 2

- **Register:** Register [online via TurboVote](#). Online voter registration for the Illinois general election is available until October 23, 2022. Same-day registration is available during [early voting or on election day](#). During this time frame, you can register and vote at the same time. Proper identification is required.
- **Vote Early:** Avoid lines on election day and vote early. All students registered in McLean County (except Bloomington residents) are eligible to vote at one of the on-campus locations.
 - October 17 - November 4
 - 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
 - Bone Student Center, Founder's Suite
 - Watterson Towers, Rosa Parks Room
- **Vote by Mail:** If you cannot make it to a polling place during an early voting time or on Election Day, you can request a ballot request application and a pre-paid envelope through [TurboVote](#). When you receive your application in the mail, you'll need to fill it out and sign it according to the instructions. November 3: Last day to [requests a Vote by Mail ballot](#) electronically.
- **Vote on Election Day:** Illinois general election day is November 8, 2022. Polling place hours are 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. If you are in line by 7 p.m., you are entitled to vote. Not sure where to go to vote, Illinois voters can [look up their polling place online](#). All students registered in McLean County (except Bloomington residents) are eligible to vote at the Bone Student Center, Brown Ball Room.

Option 3

Important Dates:

August 10: First day to request a Vote by Mail ballot

September 29: Vote by Mail ballots begin mailing to those who requested them

Oct. 17 – Nov. 4: Early voting opens at the Bone Student Center

October 23: Last day to register to vote online

November 3: Last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot electronically

November 8: Election Day and deadline for Vote by Mail ballots to be postmarked
